





When asked to speak to a group and share what Health Talents is and does, we typically speak to the holistic approach to Kingdom growth. Jesus provided us the example of healing not just the physical, but the spiritual, emotional, and social aspect of our being.

The response I feel when sharing this approach is always the same, it speaks to the inner spirit of believers, and they can relate to this type of healing. All of us can relate to some degree in that we were all lost and

marked for death, but Jesus has offered us a way to Him, a way out of our

transgressions and into His heart. A salvation that can only be found in Him and through Him, The Word.

The word on the streets of Guatemala, especially in and around our clinics is that Jesus works there. This Word has been written on the hearts of all who have had their lives transformed. Now, they share the "good news" to those who need healing. This Word was written by all who served our patients by being the hands and the feet of Jesus. The Word is an impression left on the hearts of our patients and passed on to those in need.





When a patient has been told by a healed friend where his healing came from, this patient then goes to The Healer, The Word, for their own healing. Healing is not only found for physical ailments, but the patient finds true healing when shown who the True Healer is, The Word.

Many volunteers who come to serve, report that they leave with is a feeling of being served. We always leave better, or more complete than when we came. Most of the time we are receiving healing in the same way our patients are. Our physical bodies find peace and rest, our spirits find renewal and rejuvenation, and our

social and emotional bodies find renewed restoration and

repair. It's almost like the healer finds healing and the healed become the healers.

The Word is written on our hearts for the purpose of restoring one another and finding healing in many forms. When we share what is on our hearts, we find that it not only heals those with whom we share, but it also heals us from within.

...WRITTEN ON OUR HEARTS 2 Corinthians 3:3b by Marie Agee Health Talents International was introduced to me when it was barely one year old, way back in 1974! My heart was immediately touched when I heard of the need and opportunity for medical evangelism among the Maya in Guatemala. But, it was my first medical mission trip in 1983 that sealed the deal. Two years after HTI's first medical evangelism team had been forced to evacuate Guatemala because of the intensifying civil war, the mayor of the little village where our team had worked begged us to come back with the promise that he would protect us. So, we did - and he did. We held clinic daily surrounded by an armed local militia. After supper that first evening, we gathered under the stars for a devotional encircled by our protectors. They sang along with us (in Spanish) as their rifles hung around their necks. What did we sing? "Anywhere with Jesus I can safely go." Yes, I felt God's presence that night and on many more occasions when I was working with HTI clinics. God was near that third surgical clinic as I was sitting on the supply room floor sorting medical supplies when I picked up an item I had never seen before. It appeared to be some type of suction. I shrugged and laid it to one side. Not five minutes later a nurse came running in from the operating room yelling, "I need a hemovac RIGHT NOW!" I looked up at her and whimpered, "I don't even know what that is!" She briefly described it as the one I had just picked up - the very first one we'd ever brought down. The Lord had sent it JUST IN TIME! That's often the way the Lord works. Just in time. He has always been there to provide, even when at times we didn't think things would work out, He always paved the way. Through the years in my personal life and with HTI, God has written on my heart that He loves me, takes care of me, and always will.

Our 2021 audited financial report reflects a year of preparation and construction, a year without any surgical teams and only a few mobile medical/dental teams. Thanks to you, our generous donors, Health Talents has never gone into debt to fund any programs. Our Cross Walk campaign and fundraising initiatives have yielded sufficient funds to complete and equip our post-surgical operations wing, and in 2022 our bio-hazard containment room.

Next on the list will be a full-scale lab in 2023, a new requirement from the Guatemala Ministry of Health and licensing board.
